Information You Need to Know

FutureFocus Summer Career Camps are open to students entering grades 10, 11 and 12 in fall 2007 living in Marion County. Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Requirements *Teens participating in summer camps must:*

- Sign up for only one camp
- Be currently enrolled in high school (*entering grades 10, 11, 12 in fall 2007*)
- Reside in Marion County
- Demonstrate self-motivation and self-discipline
- Complete a summer camp application
- Have a current work permit
- Complete program paperwork (Goodwill Youth Services staff will provide and assist with this during parent/guardian orientation meetings.)
- Meet Workforce Investment Act guidelines (including income guidelines)
- Parents/guardians are required to attend a camp orientation session on one of the following dates: **May 29 • June 5 • June 12 • June 19 • June 26**
